POLICY DOCUMENT ON NON-GOVERNENT SCHOLARSHIPS

Gandhi Memorial National College is a premiere institution which is continuously striving to imbibe Gandhian principles of serving the poor, needy and downtrodden people of the society. Besides, it aims at maintaining highest excellence in academics, sports and curricular activities. It blends the twin objectives by providing financial assistance and awards in the form of scholarships.

The college management is quite liberal in providing financial assistance/ scholarships to those who attain merit position in University or make achievement at University/National/International level in sports/ co-curricular/ extra-curricular activities. Besides, the financial assistance is made available to the poor, fatherless students and economically weaker and students coming from disadvantaged sections of the society.

The assistance is provided in the form of scholarships. The college has maintained transparent policy guidelines for the last several years to provide scholarships to the meritorious and needy students.

POLICY GUIDELINES FOR GRANT OF SCHOLARSHIPS

- 1. The applicant should be bonafide student of a regular course of the college.
- 2. He or she should have passed her lower examination with at least 60% marks. This condition may be relaxed for the fatherless girl child or extremely poor student or the student bringing laurels to the college at state/ national/ international level in sports/ cultural activities.
- 3. An applicant is eligible for only one type of scholarship.
- 4. The scholarship is financial support and therefore, those who are eligible to get the scholarship but can afford to pay fee will be appreciated if they surrender their right to provide opportunity to the other students who are in need of it.

POLICY:

Besides the scholarship provided by the Central/ State Government for Meritorious/ SC/ BC/ Minority/ Dependent E.S.M./ Freedom Fighter and Single Girl Child, the college does its best to look after the economically weaker and deserving students and arranges aids for them in the form of books and scholarships. The college has a transparent and fair policy regarding non-government scholarships.
