Faculty Development Programme

The Faculty of G.M.N. College kept themselves updated by completing various offline and online, orientation and refresher courses. They continued to share knowledge outside the classroom through faculty development programme.

Department of Computer Science and Applications organized a "Faculty Development Programme" on the topic- "Art of Teaching with the latest technology based on Google forms and classrooms" from 22nd November 2018 to 15th December 2018. The programme was specially initiated to foster the knowledge, skills and professional competence of faculty members. Eminent resource persons were invited. Dr. R.P Singh, Principal of GMN College welcomed the guests and shared his views on the importance of professional efficiency in higher educational institutions. Dr. Sanjeev Sofat from Punjab Engineering College expressed his views on the topic of Cyber security. Dr. Rajveer Singh Lohan, Vice-Chancellor, Maharishi Dayanand University, Rohtak highlighted the importance of

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integrating technology into teaching in sustaining academic vitality. The programme was well-received by the faculty members.

- A **professional development programme** on "How to access government sites" for non-teaching staff members was held on 19th January 2019 under the convenorship of Principal, Dr. Raj Pal Singh. The main motive and desired goal of this programme was to learn how to use technological communication devices such as computers and the internet to provide public services to teaching staff. The main thought and objective behind this programme was that a consolidated login experience would empower staff to work in concert, saving cost and would further help in reducing unnecessarily delay in the college work. The non-teaching staff was taught how to access government sites to work more efficiently.
- I On 11th February 2019, a one-day **workshop** on the use of OPAC was organized by Jaswant Rai Memorial library. In the first technical session, the resource person, Mr. Deepak (Librarian, G.M.N. College) focused on the introduction to library OPAC. He practically demonstrated how to access the electronic version of any document through BAR CODE. In the second technical session, he gave a practical demonstration about how to reserve a document in advance and how to add new books to the digital card. Both the sessions were successfully conducted. Queries raised by the participants were resolved effectively.



- I On 20 Feb., 2019, One Day workshop on the topic "On Refrence Management tools" was organized by the GMN library. It was organized to upgrade the knowledge of faculty members in the Computer world. Teachers were updated on different reference management tools such as Mendeley, Zotero, Bibexcel, Endnote etc. The workshop ended with great satisfaction.
- 1 On 25th February 2019, the Computer Science department organized a one-day Faculty Development

Programme on the topic of smart classroom-based solutions. In this FDP, a live demonstration of how to use the internet for recording the lectures was done. The training session was attended by both teaching and non-teaching staff members. Queries of staff members were taken and were resolved satisfactorily.

1 On 28th February 2019, a **one-day workshop** on the topic "Microsoft Word as a Research Tool" was organised in the college. Mr. Deepak Kumar as a resource person focused on the introduction to Microsoft Word and its usage in research and then started with the practical module namely "Reference to Microsoft Word". In the second technical session, he practically explained how to use Microsoft Word as a reference management tool and how to insert the references automatically. Both the technical sessions were handled efficiently. Faculty members expressed their satisfaction with the content delivered to them during the workshop.

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With the motive to enhance the digital knowledge of the faculty members, a **one-day workshop** on "Mendeley Reference Tools" was conducted in the college on 8th March 2019. It was organised by the Jaswant Rai Memorial Library. Mr Deepak Kumar, the keynote speaker in the first technical session gave an introduction to the Mendeley reference management tool. In the second technical session, he practically explained the Mendeley profile, how to site the sources and how to build a personal library. The session was conducted successfully.

- To keep up with the new challenges and innovations in research, the institution hosted a **one-day workshop** on "Copyright Issues in Research " on March 25, 2019 under the convenorship of Dr. Raj Pal Singh, Principal, GMN College. Mr. Deepak Kumar was the key note speaker of this workshop. In his first technical session, he dealt with Indian Copyright Law. He also highlighted the difference between plagiarism and copyright and made the participants learn how to protect the original work through copyright protection. In the second technical session, he talked about the copyright policies of journals, independent publishing and so forth. The technical session was jam-packed with new information. The workshop ended with a vote of thanks to all the participants.
 - A **one-day training programme** on "The Calculation of Income Tax and Financial Planning " was organized in the college on April 6th, 2019. The renowned chartered accountant, Mr. Vijay Gupta was the resource person. Mr. Gupta suggested various ways for enhancing individual and institutional savings. He also described the text slabs and exemption limits under various sections for the current financial year and gave several valuable tips as to how to save tax on income-generating through long-term capital gains. Further, he cautioned the staff members against the late filing of income tax returns and suggested how to save tax by investing in various government schemes and healthcare insurances. At the end of the session, Principal, Dr. Raj Pal Singh thanked Mr. Gupta for enlightening the faculty members on income tax benefits.
 - On 9th of April 2019, as part of the college's **Faculty Development Programme**, a one-day workshop on "Plagiarism Awareness" was held in the college. The keynote speaker, Mr. Deepak Kumar elaborated on the issues of plagiarism in the area of research. He also gave a detailed outline of UGC guidelines and regulations on plagiarism and academic integrity. He appealed to all the faculty members to



refrain from academic dishonesty in research and give proper credit to the sources. The faculty members shared their personal experiences and thanked the organizers for conducting this workshop on the relevant issues.

- A **one-day workshop** on "Assessing E-resources" was organized in the college on 29th April 2019. The workshop consisted of two technical sessions. In the first technical session, Mr. Deepak Kumar, Librarian, as a resource person focused on the use of the resources including N- list consortium access, open electronic resources, electronic databases, and full-text download, etc. In the second technical session, Mr. Deepak gave an elaborated introduction to KOHA integrated library management software. In this session, staff members were familiarised with the significant features of KOHA. Participants were made to learn how to access the library resources with it. In addition to this, he also demonstrated how to make comments on the desired document through personal login to KOHA and the automatic gate entry system through a Bar-Coded ID card. Both the technical sessions were attended by teaching and non-teaching staff enthusiastically.
- A **one-day workshop** on "Intellectual Property Rights " was organized on 6th May 2019. The workshop began with a welcome note by the worthy principal Dr. Raj Pal Singh a followed and the technical sessions conducted by the librarian, Mr. Deepak Kumar. In the latter part of the technical session, he discussed various intellectual property rights forms such as copyright, patents, trademarks, and trade secrets. The faculty members thanked the organizers for organizing such a brainstorming session.
- Faculty Development Programs are conducted mainly to upgrade the skills of academicians in assessing various resources. Keeping this goal in mind, a one-day workshop on "The Use of E-library " was organized in the college on 18th May 2019. The workshop started with the welcome note by the worthy Principal Dr. Raj Pal Singh followed by the technical sessions by the Librarian, Mr. Deepak Kumar. He discussed in detail the electronic resources available in the library and acquainted the participants with how they can access Erie sources such as the DOAJ, DOAB, Shodhganga, Shodhgangotri, N-LIST consortium, etc. Further, he practically made the participants learned how to access the variety of resources in Jaswant Rai Memorial electronic college library off the college. Both the technical sessions



were full of learnings and all staff members relished the content delivered to them during the workshop. The workshop ended with a vote of thanks to all the participants.

On 21st May 2019, another **workshop** on "Stress Management " was organized in the college for both teaching and nonteaching faculty members. Dr. Anupama Sihag, Assistant Professor, GMN College, emphasized that stress wreaks havoc on an individual's emotional equilibrium and disables them to function effectively. She stressed the need to identify the sources of stress in personal life as well as in professional life. Dr. Sihag also shared some stress-busting tips with the participants. She further stated that stress-free organization promotes growth and progress of the organizations. In the end, Dr. Anupama advocated learning life balance techniques to lead a happy, satisfactory and stress-free life.



For improving the professional efficiency of the employees of the college, a **Professional Development Programme** was organised on June 3rd 2019 in the college campus. In the programme, both teaching and nonteaching staff were trained in effective writing skills. The participants were trained to write documents that are grammatically correct straight to the point and save the time of the reader. Dr. Jyoti Sorout, Assistant Professor, Department of English was the chief speaker of the programme. She gave valuable tips to the participants on writing good letters and emails. She urged the participants for becoming computer proficient in the technology driven world. She also showed the proper formats of various types of applications written to the officials and gave valuable tips for writing good reports and seminar proposals. At the end of the programme queries from the participants were taken and resolved keenly and efficiently.

A stress management **workshop** was organized on 25th June 2019 in the college by Dr. Anupama Sihag from the Psychology Department. She mainly talked about the everincreasing numbers of psychological disorders in society, causing dissatisfaction, unhappiness and stress among the youth as well as the professionals. She remarked that stress, when ignored, can take the form of pressure which most likely disrupts the normal free mind of an individual. She stressed the need for stress management strategies especially among employees so that the mismatch between personal inspirational goals and ever-increasing pressures of meeting deadlines in the working areas could be tackled easily. Dr. Anupama advocated the use of stress management techniques



in attaining job satisfaction. Dr. Raj Pal Singh, Principal, also advised the participants to follow yoga as a wonderful coping technique to deal with stress. All the participants were benefited, energized and confident at the end of the session.




