

Ambala Cantt college clinches first spot in dist-level science quiz

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GMN College, Ambala Cantonment, recently hosted a district-level science quiz, organised under the sponsorship of the Haryana State Council for Science, Innovation and Technology, Department of Science and Technology, Haryana.

Twelve teams from seven institutes participated in the screening round of the competition.
