Many students won exciting prizes as well.



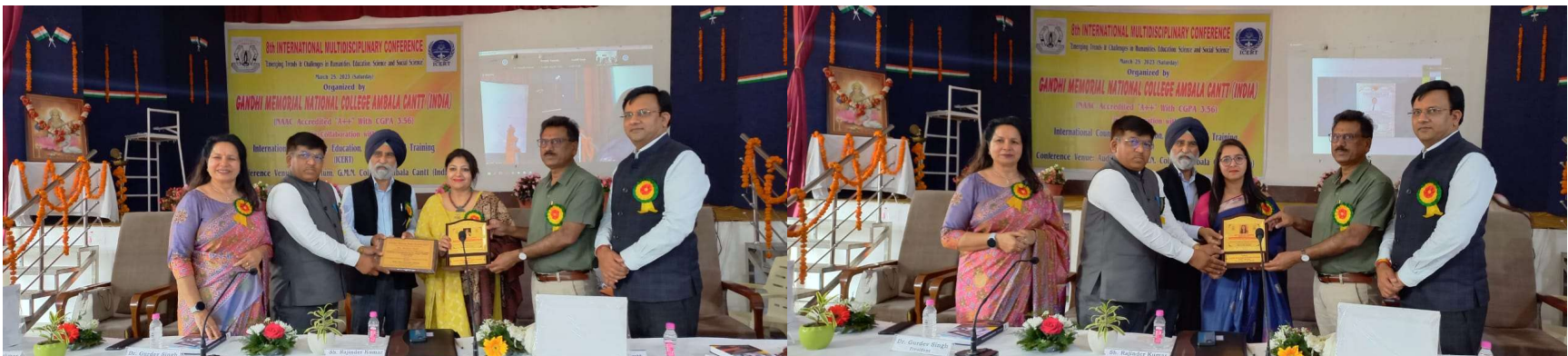
