

## REPORT

On January 15, 2022, a one-day National webinar was organized by Department of Commerce and Management in collaboration with Entrepreneurship Club of Gandhi Memorial National College, Ambala Cantt on the theme "Entrepreneurial Skills". The webinar was presided over by the college Principal, Dr. Rajpal Singh. Organizing secretary of the webinar, Dr. Suman invited the Principal to formally welcome the chief guest and the keynote speaker of the webinar. Principal, Dr. Rajpal Singh, welcoming the keynote speaker Dr. Kuldeep Singh Chhikara, from Maharishi Dayanand University, Rohtak, said that the topic on which Professor Chhikara will present the lecture today is very meaningful because it is very essential to know the major cause of unemployment that is on a large scale. This is because of the inadequate and inferior skill training to the youth. A brief presentation was made by Dr. Surendra Kundu, the convener of the webinar, in the context of the introduction of the topic and he said that this topic will prove to be very beneficial for all the participants because today only 7% of youth in India are formally or informally trained with skills and Entrepreneurial wisdom. The co-convener of the webinar, Dr. Bharti Vij presented his views about the development of enterprise management skills with reference to the introduction of the topic. After this, Professor Chhikara told in his speech that the vision of the government was that the people who got the skills and training under their policies would turn towards self-employment. This will increase and provide employment to the youth but only a small percentage of people started their own businesses. He said that at the root of the problem of entrepreneurial skills, skill development and unemployment in India is the absence of vocational education at the school level and ineffective implementation of various skill development schemes. India can take inspiration from various developed countries and countries of East Asia. Dr. Surendra Kundu, the program convener said that 293 participants participated in this webinar and got subtle knowledge about the subject. Dr. VK Jain, Head of Commerce Department, while presenting the formal thanks, said that today's event is very successful and for this event, he thanked the President of the College Governing Body Mr. Gurudev Singh, Principal Dr. Rajpal Singh, the keynote speaker Dr. Kuldeep Singh Chhikara, Commerce and Management Department and congratulated to the entire organizing team and all the participants.


**Workshop on IPR and Patent Filing**



Considering that entrepreneurship ability is diversified, build an entrepreneurial competency framework that includes opportunity identification, entrepreneurial skills that represent "resources," action areas, and 15 competency lists. compared models and classifications of entrepreneurial abilities, arguing that entrepreneurial abilities consist of personality traits, entrepreneurial knowledge, and skills. The research on entrepreneurial ability is increasingly concerned with relevant knowledge and experience to improve skills and develop potential resources to enhance innovation.
