REPORT OF THE TWO DAY NATIONAL SEMINAR

Department of Commerce & Management

Two days national seminar on "Role of IPR in present scenario" on 30 & 31 March, 2018 was organised by Department of Commerce & Management, G.M.N. College, Ambala Cantt and sponsored by Director General Higher Education, Haryana, Panchkula. The seminar was started with lighting of lamp by the Keynote speaker and Chief Guest Prof. M.S. Turan, who is ex-dean academic, GJU, Hisar, worthy Principal and patron of the seminar Dr. Raj Pal Singh, Dr. V.K. Jain, HOD, Commerce & Management and convenor of the seminar and other staff members. The Principal formally welcomed Prof. Turan and emphasized that he is the best administrator and expert in the field of Intellectual Property Rights, followed by Dr. V.K. Jain who explained the relevance of the seminar in the present era and also told that college has organised the seminar on same topic in the year 2004, also. But due to the continuous changes in the environment, IPRs has now known as a bundle of job opportunities also.

He also welcomed the Keynote speaker, Principal, Delegates, Students and media persons present over there. Prof. M.S. Turan was invited to deliver his Keynote address. According to his opinion the topic of the seminar is multi disciplinary and having tropical interest. Patent can be studied as the topic of science field while we can take commercial advantage of the same in the field of commerce. He also emphasized on the process of registering IPRs and how with the permission of WTO, the changes can be made. He also motivated the researchers and students to start their own business in the field of Intellectual Properties. He divided the innovations into two parts. First one is registered for which they can get royality while the second one is not registered with the help of which they can start their own business even without having finance. These businesses may be initiated with the help of angel investors or HNIs (High Networth Individuals). He also gave the examples of some reputed companies in the field of IPRs like Zomato, OLA and UBER. After the tea break, first technical session was started in which Dr. Ajit Singh (Associate Prof. and HOD of Commerce & Management, Govt. College, Ambala Cantt) was the Resource Person. He gave his opinion for the youth of India as job providers and not as job seekers. For this purpose the youth should be creative and idea generation should be there. He considered Intellectual Property as the fourth means of production alongwith Land, Labour and Capital. He also informed about various subsidies, tax relaxations and deductions provided by Govt. of India to promote IPRs. He also discussed the challenges which the Govt. have to face while granting Intellectual Property Rights. About 20 Research papers were presented by different research scholars from the different colleges, Universities and Institutes. The topics of their research papers were:-

- 1. Impact of IPR on Indian Economy.
- Role of IPR in Education Sector.
- 3. Role of IPR in present scenario.
- 4. WTO and IPR regime.
- 5. IPR in Indian Aggriculture.
- IPR in developing country.
- 7. Role of IPR in Economic growth etc.

Second technical session was chaired by Dr. Mukesh Trehan, Associate Prof., S.A. Jain College, Ambala City and Resource Person was Dr. Dalip Kumar, Dean and Chairperson of Department of Law, KUK. He told that how IPR Law is playing a vital role to protect the inventions and research. He highlighted the history of IPR and discussed about the various amendments that came into force till the introduction of IPR in 1994. He also briefed National IPR policy. He raised questions like:

- 1. What is the actual place of traditional knowledge and its role?
- 2. Who will monitor the infringement?
- 3. How to sensitize society about infringement?

Three papers were presented by delegates from different colleges. Their topics were:

- 1. Impact of IPR on Indian Economy.
- 2. Role of IPR in Economic growth.
- 3. IPR in Indian scenario

The session was summed up by the vote of thanks by Dr. V.K. Jain.

The second day of National Seminar was chaired by Prof. P.J. Phillip, who is former Prof. of Management at NIT Kurukshetra and the Resource Person of the third technical session.

The topic of his presentation was IPR: celebrating inventions and innovations. He said various rights are granted for innovation and invention and also discussed the time period for protection. He also discussed that IP can be licensed, sold, gifted or inherited. He discussed the things which can not be patented. He highlighted that the products are patentable but not the plants because these are the gifts from nature. In trade marks he mentioned coca cola to be the most expensive trade mark in the rational of IPRs, IP protection encourages innovations. He also mentioned that IP rights can be obtained by anyone or everyone.

Fourth session was Industry Interface, in this session Resource Person was K.G. Maheshwari. Senior Advocate, discussed about the various types of IPR and the difference between them. He told about MADRID which is a WIPO through which one can file application in 116 countires at a time. He also explained the terms trademarks passing off and infringement with practical examples. He discussed the classifications of trademarks, Law of tort etc. Papers presented in this session are:-

- 1. Impact of IPR with Indian and Foreign.
- 2. IPR in India.
- 3. Impact of WTO on Foreign Trade

In all there were 118 delegates out of which about 30 papers were presented and rest of them were deemed to be presented.
